

ATTENTION FLEA MARKET VENDORS!

Make plans for the 47th annual Steele City Flea Market & Antique Farm Machinery Show SEPTEMBER 16 & 17, 2017 Steele City, Nebraska

HOURS: Published hours for the Flea Market are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Vendor registration will be open from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Friday, and 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday, located near the intersection of Main and Ida streets. We ask that all vendors stop by the registration booth before setting up.

SPACE INFORMATION: A standard vendor space is 23' long x 15' deep. We will try to accommodate longer campers when possible. All spaces are outdoors. No indoor spaces available.

COST: Pre-register and reserve your space for \$20 per space per day (\$40 for the weekend). All *unreserved* spaces are FREE on a first-come first-served basis starting the Friday of the Flea Market.

ELECTRICITY: There will be a charge of \$15.00 for vendors requiring electricity. Electric hookups must be reserved in advance, because the number of hookups is VERY limited. Food vendors, those who absolutely need it to run a business, and those who require it for medical reasons have first priority to electricity.

REFUNDS: No refunds after September 1st, unless prior arrangements have been made with the vendor coordinator.

TAXES: Payment of Nebraska Sales Tax is your responsibility. The Sales Tax rate is 5.5%

OTHER: No food or beverages may be sold at the fair without prior approval from the vendor coordinator. This includes food vendors with a valid Nebraska Food Permit. A copy of this permit must be available to the vendor coordinator if requested. No alcoholic beverage sales are allowed.

We take pride in having a clean event and work hard to keep it that way. We appreciate your help and cooperation. No draining of sewage is allowed on Flea Market or town premises. Garbage cans and dumpsters will be located throughout the flea market. If you need a garbage bag, please let us know. Public restrooms and shower house are located in the City Park. Portable facilities will also be available.

MOTELS/CAMPING: Motels are available in Washington, KS, Beatrice or Fairbury, NE. Camping is available at Rock Creek Station SHP or Crystal Springs Campground in Fairbury. RV parks are available in Endicott, NE and Steele City, NE.

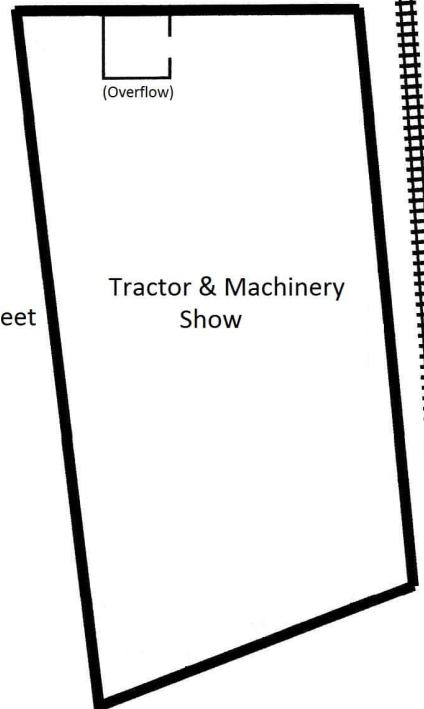
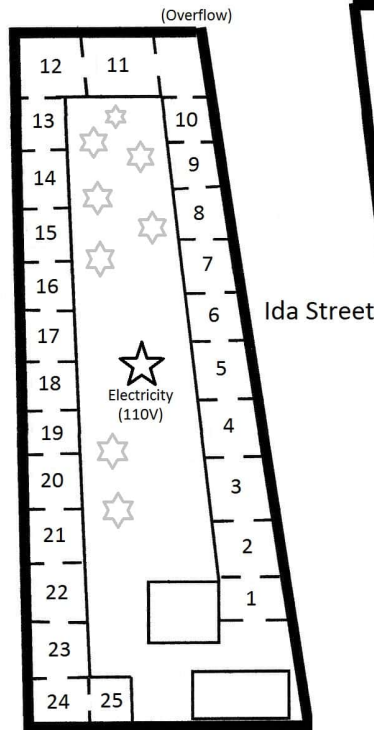
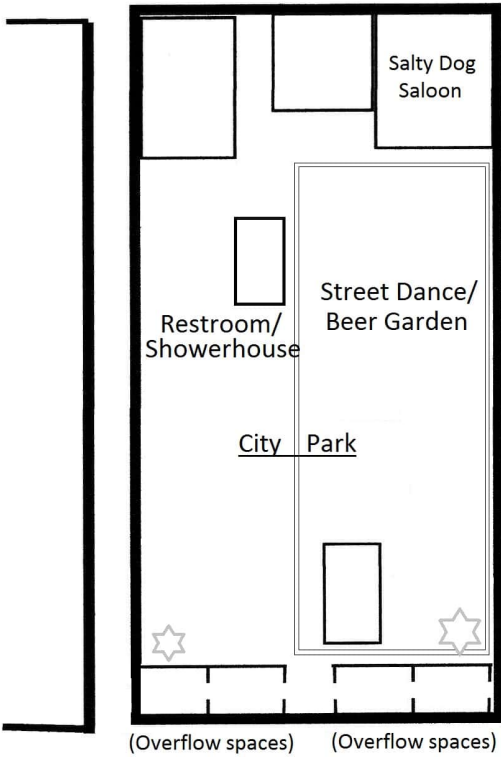
